- Management Information (MA1)

Diploma in Financial and Management Accounting RQF Level 3 (3 months)

- Managing Financial Records (FA2)
- Managing Costs and Finance (MA2)

Diploma in Accounting and Business RQF Level 4 (6 months)

- Business and Technology (FBT)
- Management Accounting (FMA)
- Financial Accounting (FFA)

Foundations in Professionalism (Online)

The exam is computer based on demand.

Entry requirements

- KCSE: Mean grade C OR C- with passes in five different subjects including English and Mathematics
- IGCSE: Must have the O level certificate with 5 principal passes including English and Mathematics.

OR

- Any other relevant qualification approved by ACCA.

Mode of Assessment

The exams are on demand computer based.

Progression

Upon passing all seven exams and then completing the Foundations in Professionalism online module, the student obtains the Foundation Diploma and becomes eligible for the ACCA Qualification.
