
### Public transport

## **Program Description**

The program is offered at Oshwal College in collaboration with the University of Hertfordshire. UK.

The programme aims to promote the employability of its graduates in order to allow them thrive in an increasingly competitive environment. It achieves this through a blend of academic study, intercultural awareness and employability /enterprise skills development.

Graduates of this Business programme are equipped for the demands of a career in business and management. The programme graduates will be able to contribute to the dynamic and complex business environment both in a local and global context.

# **Career Opportunities**

There are several career opportunities available to BABA graduates. The programme prepares students into all functions of a business and gives them a holistic view that can be applied in any business or industry. The graduates will therefore be eligible for various career positions in the fields of marketing, accounting and finance, international trade, human resources, economics, entrepreneurship, project management amongst others.

## **Programme Structure**

The programme is designed to take duration of 3 years.

#### Year 1

Students are required to complete compulsory 8 modules each worth 15 credits in order to progress to level 5. The modules are spread over semesters A, B and C.

#### Year 2

Students are required to complete compulsory 8 modules each worth I5 credits in order to progress to level 6. The modules are spread over semesters A, B and C.

#### Year 3

Students are required to complete 8 compulsory modules each worth 15 credits in order to graduate with an Honours degree. The modules are spread over semesters A, B and C.

- Business and Commercial Awareness
- Global Marketing, Ethics, and Culture
- International Human Resource Management
- Leadership and Organisations
- Issues in the Global Economy
- Digital Economy
- Contemporary Issues in Business

# **Entry Requirements**

The programme is offered to students with relevant entry qualifications and leads to an award of a BA (Hons) Business

Administration Degree. Students will be able to start at Level 4 or 5 depending on prior learning qualifications.

## Minimum Entry Requirements:

Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (or equivalent examination) certificate with a minimum mean grade of C+ (Plus), or

- ABE Diploma Level 5, or
- BTEC HND in Business, or
- A Diploma in Business from a recognized Institution of Higher Learning subject to approval by the University of Hertfordshire, or
- A holder of a Diploma validated by the Commission for University Education with at least a credit, or a professional certificate in relevant discipline from a recognized institution or equivalent.

### Mode of Assessment

All the modules in the programme are assessed by coursework which entails assignments and online tests. This mode of assessment allows students to apply the knowledge learned during the course of study while identifying and filling in the gaps by undertaking independent research on certain themes.

### **Academic Progression**

With a BABA qualification, a graduate is eligible to pursue a master's degree in any field of study. There is also a considerable amount of credit transfer when pursuing a business professional course such as ACCA, CPA, CIPS and CHRP.
